#### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Students complete 1500 hours of instruction over two school years to meet licensure requirements by the Indiana State Board of Cosmetology. Students who complete the requirements are prepared to take the state licensing examination. In order to accumulate the hours required, students must attend Cosmetology I and II and attend three-week sessions during the summer. Topics covered include roller control, quick styling, shampooing, hair coloring, permanent waving, facials, manicuring, business and personal ethics, bacteriology, and sanitation.

## **MAJOR LEARNING OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Apply principles of professional and career development to succeed in the cosmetology industry.
- 2. Demonstrate appropriate sanitation precautions and first aid procedures to ensure proper salon standards.
- 3. Analyze the anatomy and physiology of the human body as it relates to the cosmetology profession.
- 4. Analyze principles of chemistry and electricity as they relate to cosmetology.
- 5. Evaluate trichology as it relates to cosmetology.
- 6. Apply the principles of hair design to create hair styles.
- 7. Demonstrate mastery of haircutting techniques.
- 8. Demonstrate mastery of hairstyling techniques.
- 9. Demonstrate mastery of chemical texturizing of hair.
- 10. Demonstrate mastery of hair coloring techniques.
- 11. Evaluate wigs, hairpieces, and extensions to use a choice in hairstyling.
