## X A TYPICAL STUDENT

## GET YOURSELF READY

To be prepared, be on track for graduation and have room in your course schedule to attend the Cosmetology program for two years. Also be prepared to attend the required summer sessions. # X YEAR ONE

Students complete 1500 hours of instruction over two school years to meet licensure requirements by the Indiana State Board of Cosmetology. Students who complete the requirements are prepared to take the state licensing examination. Students must attend Cosmetology I and II to accumulate the hours required. Students demonstrate proficiency in roller control, quick styling, shampooing, hair coloring, permanent waving, facials, manicuring, business and personal ethics, bacteriology, and sanitation. Students must attend the summer sessions to complete the required hours.

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Students are required to attend summer Cosmetology for two years in order to accrue the required hours.



## X YEAR TWO

Second-year students complete the 1500 hours of required instruction learning advanced skills in styling, hair coloring, permanent waving, facials and manicuring. Students will also study anatomy and physiology, professionalism, and salon management in relation to cosmetology. The salon is open to the public, and students gain experience working with clients.

Upon completing this program and passing the State examination, students become licensed and are prepared to be employed in a salon. Students also pursue 2 and 4-year postsecondary degrees in business, fashion design, or related fields and work their way through college.
