GRADUATION PATHWAYS REQUIREMENTS

Beginning with the class of 2023, Indiana students must satisfy requirements in all 3 Graduation Pathways to earn a high school diploma. PATHWAY 1

**HIGH SCHOOL
DIPLOMA**
(meet diploma requirements)

5 HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS - DIRECTED ELECTIVES

- CTE courses

6 HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS - ELECTIVES

- CTE pathway courses recommended

TECHNICAL HONORS DIPLOMA

- 6 high school credits in CTE pathway
- Industry-recognized credential or certification
- 6 transcribed dual credits
- C or better in courses that count toward the diploma
- GPA of B or better

(complete at least one)

WORK-BASED LEARNING

- Enrollment in the 13 WCC programs
- Work product documentation
 - Technical Skills Evaluation
 - Essential Skills Evaluation
 - Other documentation

READY**
(complete at least one)

HONORS DIPLOMA

- Technical Honors Diploma

- C average across courses
